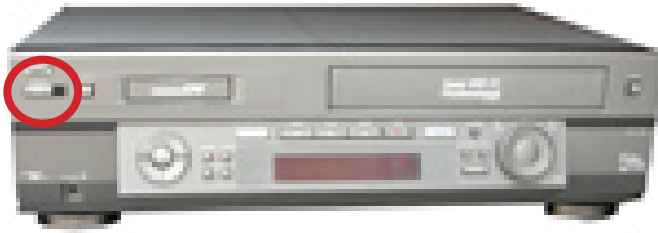


JVC DECK *CAPTURE mini DV INTO ADOBE PREMIERE CS3*

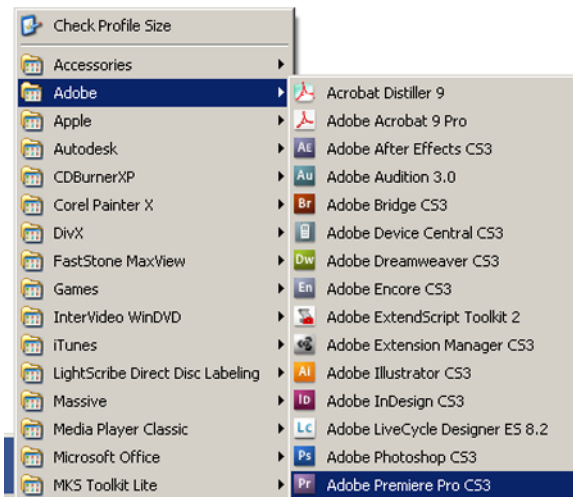


1 **POWER ON THE JVC DECK**
*Turn on the deck
Turn on the monitor on top of
the decks to preview without the
computer.*

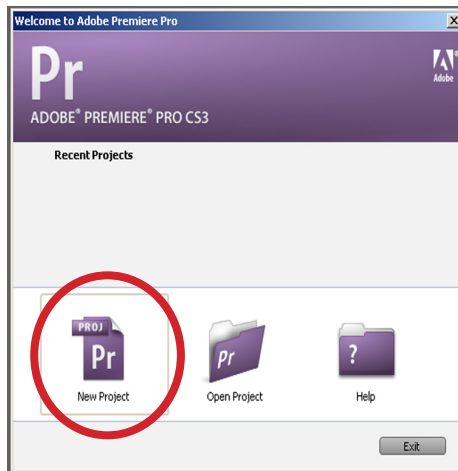
ROUTE THE JVC DECK

miere CS3*



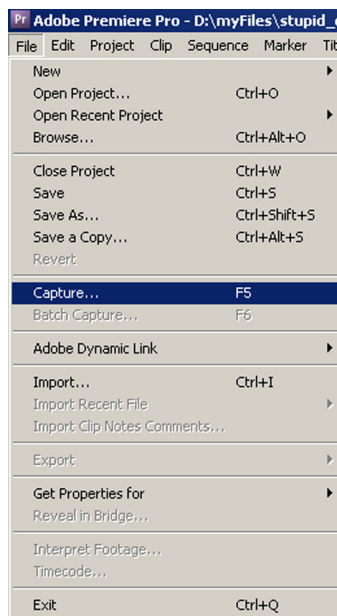
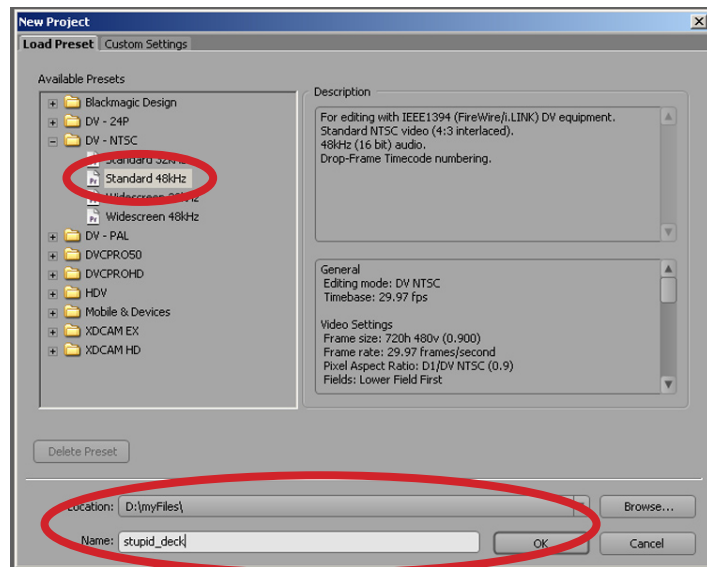
4 New Project Select New Project

5 MOVIE SETTINGS

Under the DV-NTSC folder choose Standard 48kHz or whatever setting you wish to record in.

Under Location create a folder for yourself on the "D:\:" drive and give your project a Name.

Click OK



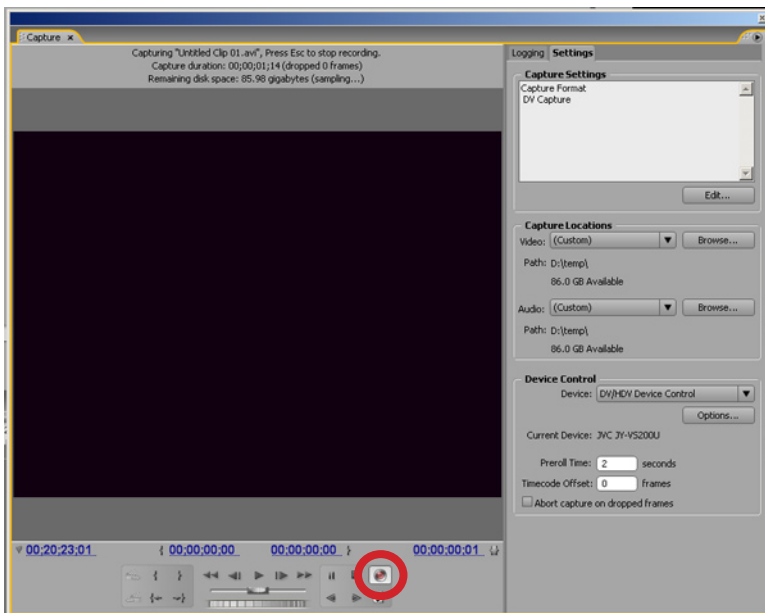
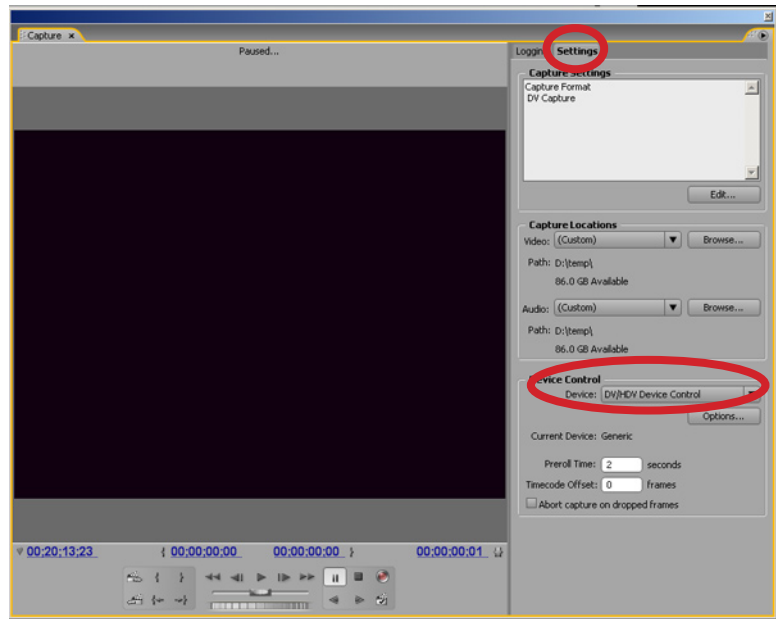
6 CAPTURE Choose File > Capture from the top menu bar

Capture Deck Setup

Select the Settings tab

Under Device Control, the default settings for DV/HDV Device Control should work. If you want to record from VHS or the DVD/VHS deck change the Device control to "None"

Record

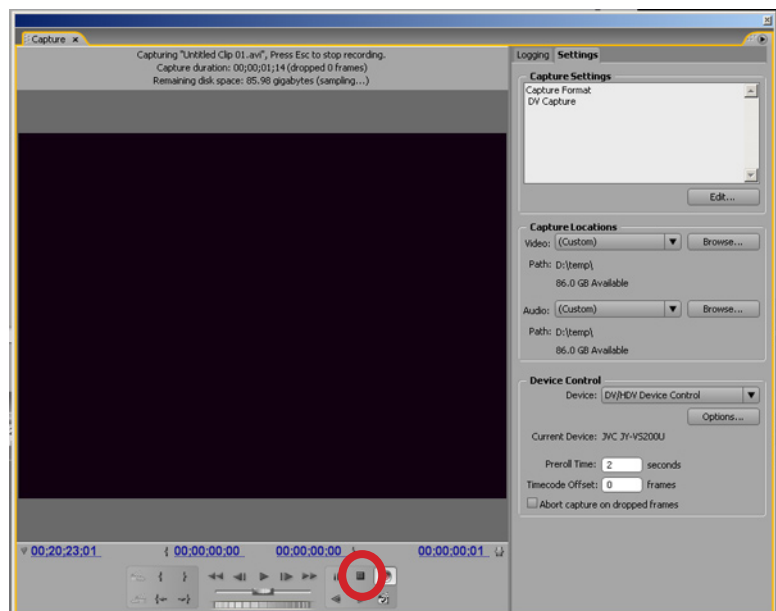
Cue up your tape and click record when you are ready to record. If using miniDV You can use the Logging tab to setup multiple In/Out points

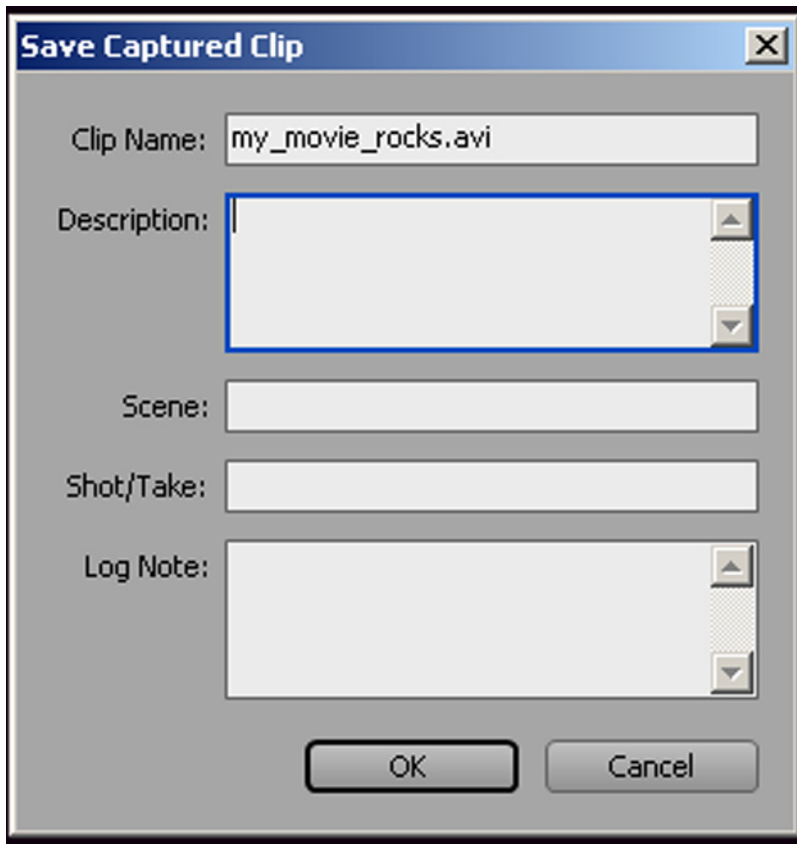
** You should be able to see your image in the Premiere preview window when cueing up your media.

Stop Recording

When you are finished click the stop button. If recording using the batch recording it should stop when completed

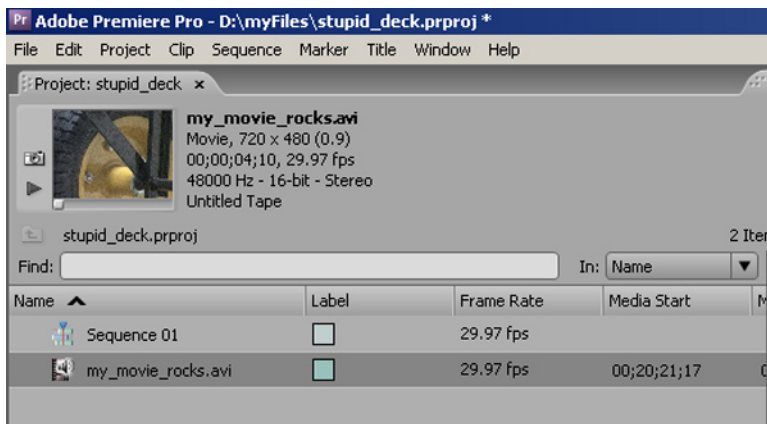

Save Captured Clip

Give your clip a name and enter other information if needed.
