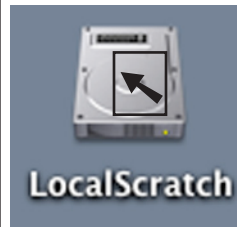


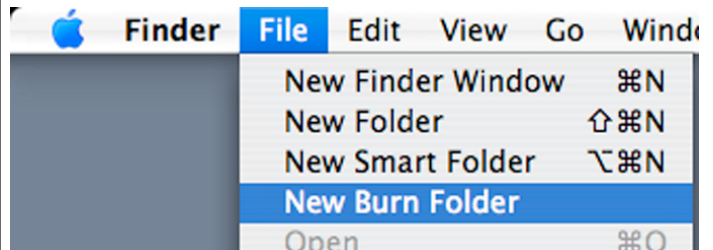
How to Burn A CD or DVD in OS X 10.4

1. Double-click on LocalScratch to open a Finder window.



2. From the menu
Select File
New Burn Folder.

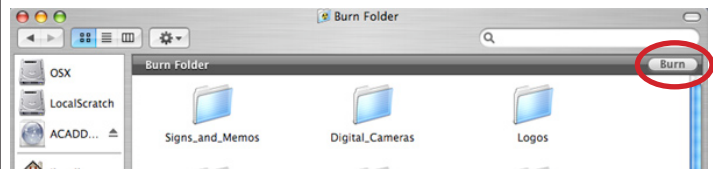
This will create a new folder with a title of "Burn Folder". If desired, the folder can be renamed to something more appropriate.



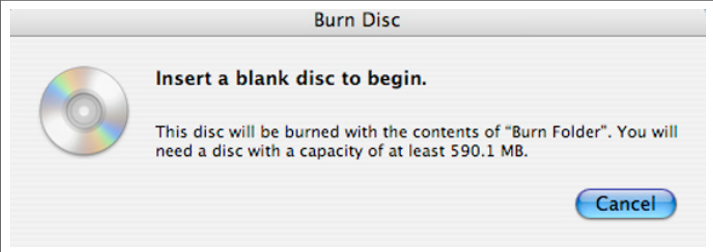
3. Drag files to the Burn Folder.

4. Confirm contents by double-clicking on the folder

5. When ready, click the Burn button at the top right-hand side of the Finder window

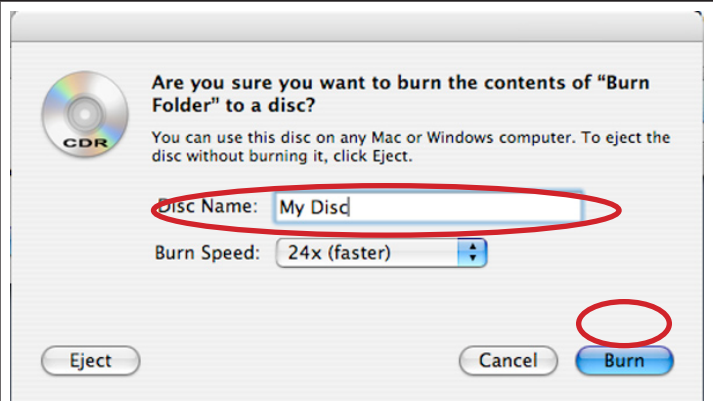


6. The Burn Disc dialogue window appears, prompting for a blank disc: INSERT BLANK DISC NOW and wait. Please do not select Cancel. If you did eject your disc and go back to step 5.

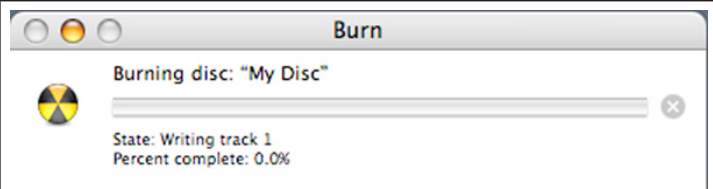


7. Name the disc and select the burn speed.

8. Click on Burn button when ready.



9. Progress window will appear when files are queued up, during the burn process, and when disc contents are verified.



9. Once finished, an icon for the newly burned disc will appear on the Desktop.
